

Dual Credit

La Monte offers dual credit courses to juniors and seniors in order to gain college credit, while still in high school. This is a wonderful opportunity to get a jump-start on college credits. Students can either take courses through the University of Central Missouri (UCM) or State Fair Community College (SFCC). Students must be prepared to participate in a college course and be responsible for keeping up with the course on their own. It is also the responsibility of the student to be sure the class they take transfers to their college of choice upon graduation.

University of Central Missouri (UCM)

Eligibility requirements: junior/senior, 3.0 cumulative GPA, recommended by school official, met specific ACT requirements for math/English courses

Cost: \$100 per credit hour (most classes are 3 credit hours)

Classes Available: Students can take a variety of courses and have various options (ITV or online). See Mrs. Ming for an exact listing of what is offered. Classes previously taken by other students include: college algebra, college English, public speaking, intro to criminology, and psychology.

State Fair Community College (SFCC)

Eligibility requirements: junior/senior, 3.0 cumulative GPA, recommended by school official, met specific ACT requirements for math/English courses

Cost: \$70 per credit hour + textbook cost
